George Dunscombe was Vicar of Waver Wotton in
Warwickshire, where he died, he was a man of
extraordinary worth in his time & whose memory was
long lamented & revered in his parish. he was buried
in the south aisle of his Church, & over his grave lies a
white freestone, with the following inscription almost
worn out, and not mentioned by Dugdale.

September 12, 1652, died, and here lyeth
Interred the body of the industrious, learned,
Humble, Peaceable, Charitable and Faithful
Pastor of Wotton Waver, Mr. George Dunscombe.

of extraordinary worth in his time, a good scholar
and an honest & pious man whose memory is very
great to this day. Col's Collect towards athenae
Cantab. Vol 5. pag 122. The Rev. Horatio Goldway the present
Curate of Wotton Waver tells me that on referring to certain books of
the Vicar (the Divines) presented to the Church then by the Rev. Geo. Dunscombe
he found he always spelt his name "Duncombe", but that there is no trace of
the name in the Parish registers which do not commence until 1653.
